Leotard, pink tights, pink leather or canvas ballet shoes (no shorts). Same color skirt permitted. Hair must be pulled back tightly in bun with a hairnet. Secured with pins.

### HIP HOP

Black leggings, black shorts with tan tights, or sweatpants. Tank top or leotard with black hip hop shoes. Hair must be pulled back tightly in a bun or ponytail. **K-2nd Grade:** Black and White Low top Converse - or similar **Level 1 and Up:** Black with White Trim Pastry Pop Tart Dance Sneakers

## JAZZ/HIP HOP COMBO

Black shorts or leggings. Black fitted tank top or leotard. Hair must be pulled back tightly in a bun or ponytail. Black slip on split sole shoes AND Black and White low top Converse - or similar.

## **CREATIVE MOVEMENT/TAP COMBO**

Leotard, pink tights, pink leather or canvas ballet shoes. Hair in a bun. Black tap shoes.

## ACRO

Black shorts or leggings . Black fitted tank top or leotard. Hair must be pulled back tightly in a bun or ponytail. No shoes required.

**Please note:** You will be given until September 28th to get your attire purchased. After that, you will be required to come in the proper attire. If you do not have the proper attire, we will give you the required attire through our EPD boutique and automatically charge your card on file.

#### **POOR TRAVELING CONDITIONS**

- IN CASE OF BAD CONDITIONS (SNOW, ICE, EARTHQUAKE, ETC.), YOU CAN CHECK OUR FACEBOOK PAGE FOR INFORMATION. DECISIONS ON CLOSURES OF CLASSES ARE MADE 2 HOURS BEFORE CLASSES START, SO PLEASE CHECK OUR FACEBOOK FREQUENTLY FOR CLASS CANCELLATIONS.
- THERE ARE NO TUITION CREDITS GIVEN FOR POOR CONDITIONS CLOSURES; ANY CLASSES MISSED DUE TO WEATHER RELATED CLOSINGS MAY BE MADE UP WITH ANOTHER CLASS IN THE SAME SEMESTER LIKE ANY OTHER ABSENCE.

#### **CLASS PLACEMENT & ETIQUETTE**

- Faculty reserves the right to place students in classes which are age appropriate and reflective of technical ability.
- A placement class may be required depending on the class level. Please speak with the EPD Director to schedule an evaluation or email <u>Alyse@eastpointedance.com</u>
- Schedule is subject to change based on enrollment. Minimum of 5 dancers to run a class.
- It is disrespectful to both faculty and students when a student enters the classroom late. Please be dressed and prepared for class by the time the class starts. If you are running late or know you will not be on time, please let the front desk know and they will inform your teacher.
  - If you are 15 minutes late without notifying the studio, the instructor reserves the right to dismiss you from class.
  - If you are absent when new choreography is taught, the instructor reserves the right to remove you from that section of the dance.
- Remember to respect your teachers, peers and the studio. Bullying, forming cliques, and being disrespectful is not tolerated at EPD. No talking during corrections. Be prepared to begin class when the instructor is at the studio. Those who have repeated issues will be asked to leave EPD without a refund.
- Cell phones, food, and drinks must be left outside of the studio. <u>Only water</u> is permitted inside the studios and when instructors give water breaks.
- Limit your bathroom trips during class. Please use the restroom before and after your classes.

#### ATTENDANCE

- Please notify the front desk or your instructor if you know you will not be attending class.
- If you miss class, you can make it up by taking any other class that is in your level. If you are not sure what class to take, you can ask your instructor or the front desk.
